Elephant Head Lodge

The Elephant Head Lodge, named for its proximity to a local rock formation, is an arrangement of fifteen cabins located around a very early log cabin lodge and dining room. The Lodge and the “honeymoon” Trapper cabin were both built in 1910 by Buffalo Bill Cody’s niece, Josephine Thurston and her husband, Harry W. Thurston. Harry chose the site for its water. He was a supervisor with the Forest Service and knew the spring, that still serves the lodge today, had been a dependable source of good water for early travelers to Yellowstone and for the trappers and Indians before them.
